



Gemini

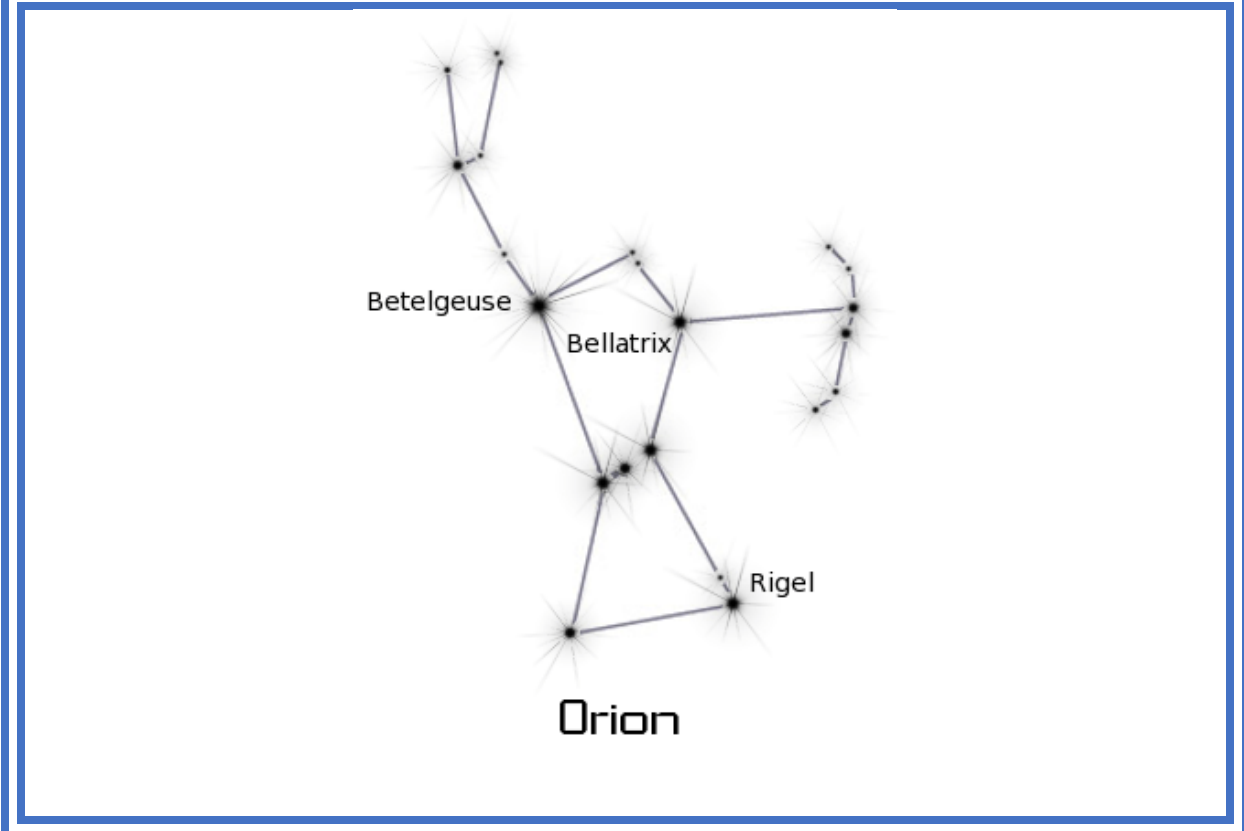
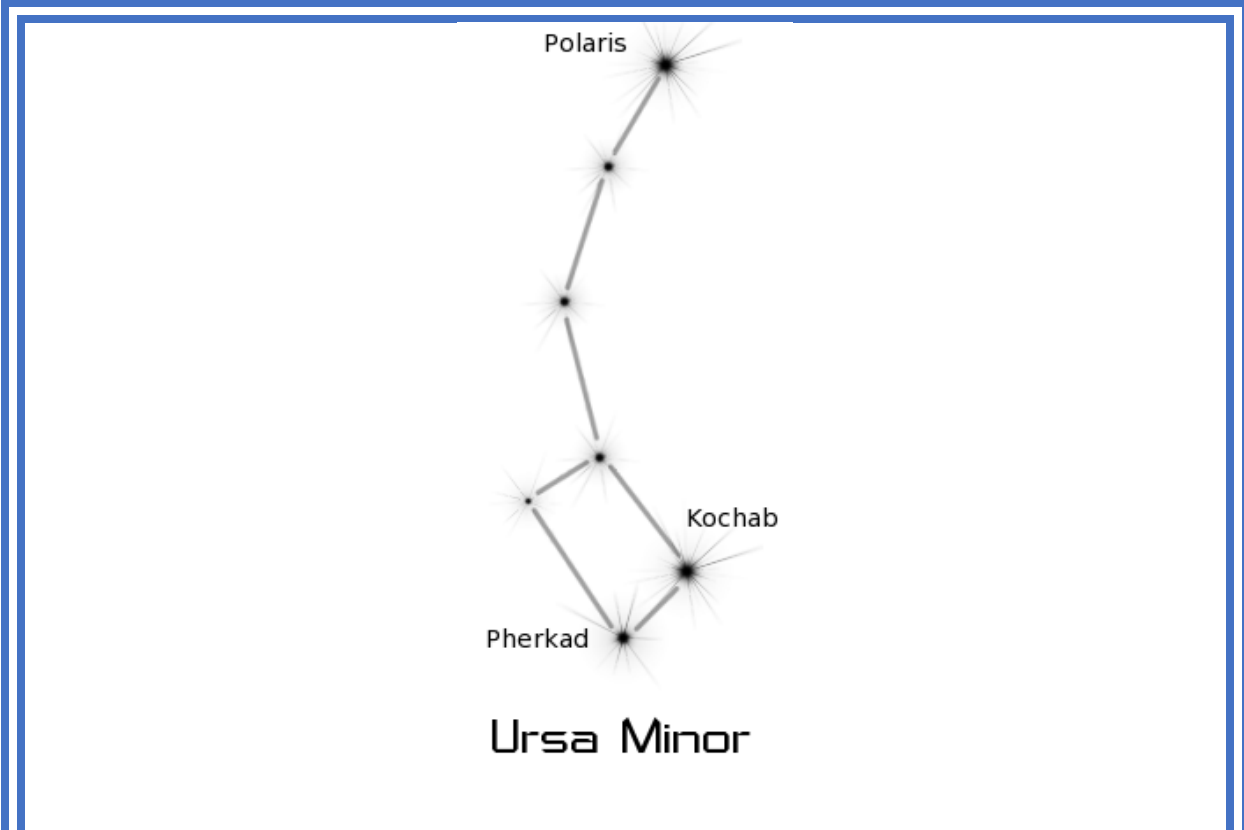

Hercules

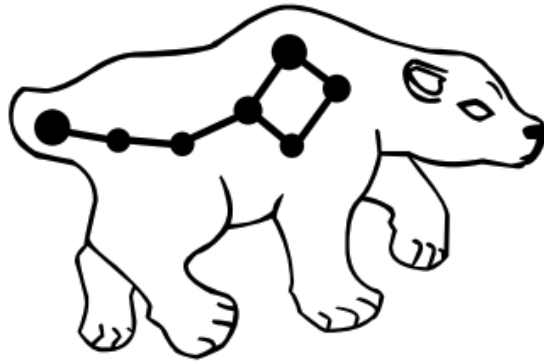

Ursa Minor

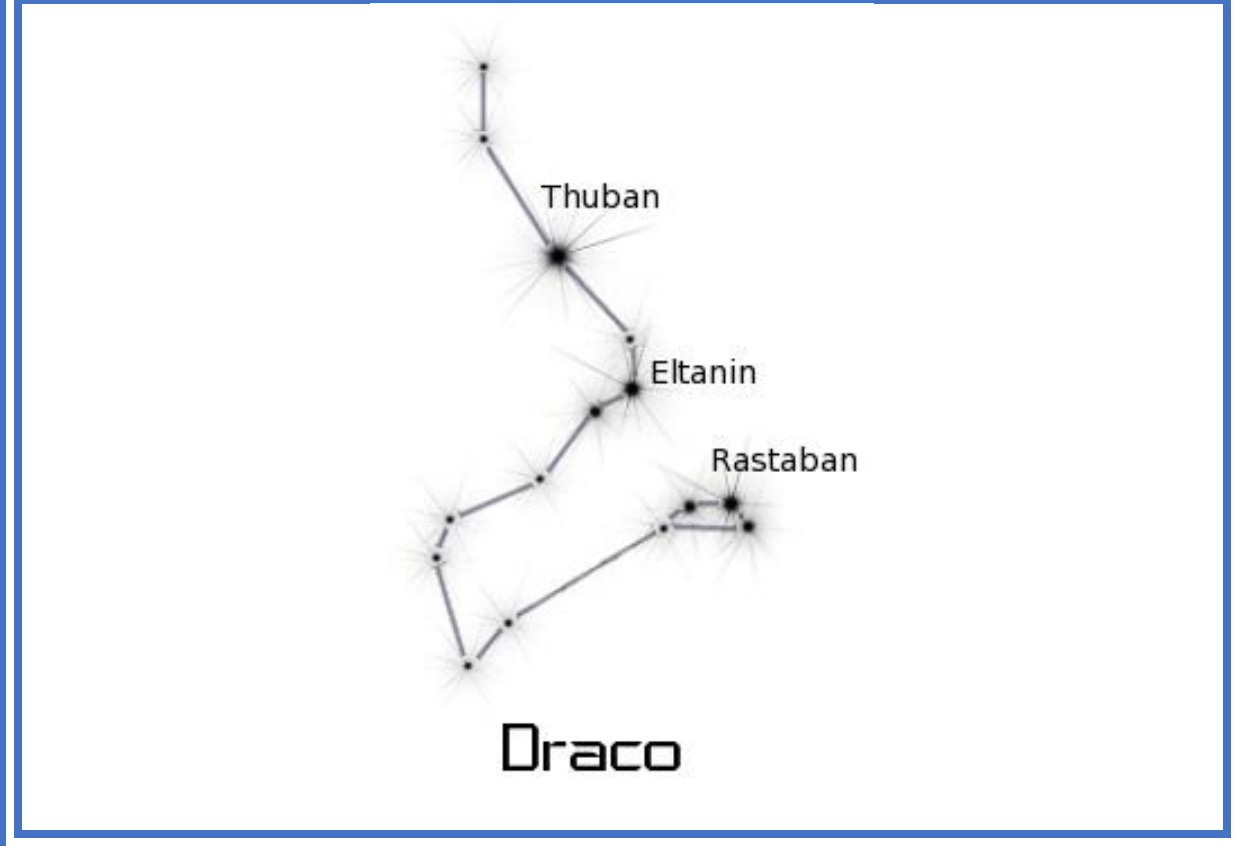
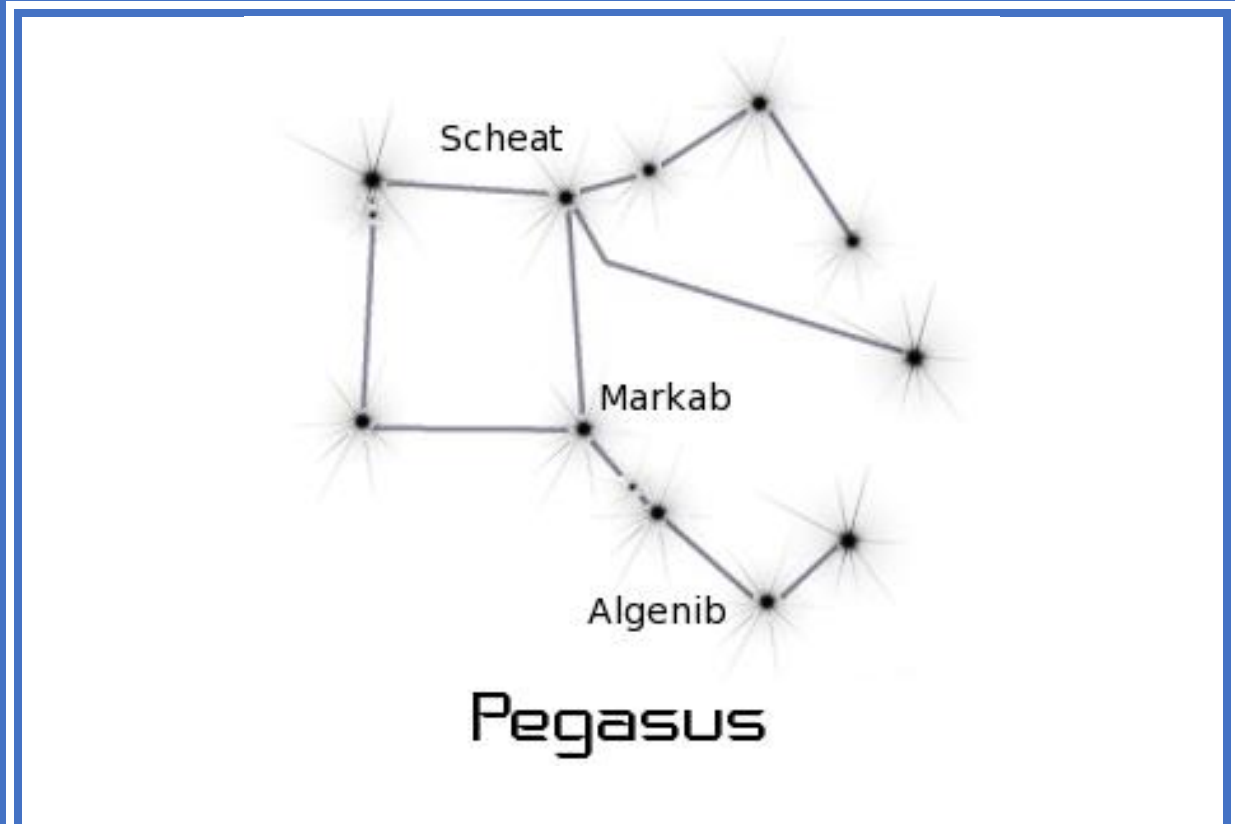
